**Grand Bauhinia Medal (GBM)**

The Honourable LEE Ka-chiu, John, SBS, PDSM

Mr LEE is awarded GBM in recognition of his dedicated and distinguished public service to the Government and the Hong Kong community over the past 44 years, particularly his sterling contributions during his tenure as the Secretary for Security and the Chief Secretary for Administration. With his strong commitment to Hong Kong and outstanding ability and experience in public administration, he assisted the then Chief Executive in rising to the challenges and played an instrumental role in co-ordination in policy formulation and implementation, making significant contributions to Hong Kong.

The Honourable CHEUNG Yu-yan, Tommy, GBS, JP

Mr CHEUNG has a long record of dedicated and distinguished public service and commands the respect of the catering business sector. As a Non-official Member of the Executive Council and a Member of the Legislative Council representing the Catering Functional Constituency, Mr CHEUNG has been serving as a bridge between the sector and the Government, playing an important role in offering invaluable advice to both. In particular, during the COVID-19 pandemic, Mr CHEUNG has displayed strong leadership in promptly liaising with the trade in the fight against the pandemic, and making remarkable contributions towards the Government's smooth implementation of social distancing measures, improvement of indoor air ventilation in food premises, and relief measures for the trade. He is awarded GBM in recognition of his exemplary contributions to Hong Kong.

The Honourable Mr Justice Roberto Alexandre Vieira RIBEIRO

Mr Justice RIBEIRO joined the Judiciary in 1999 and was appointed as Permanent Judge of the Court of Final Appeal in 2000. He is the longest serving and senior Permanent Judge of the Court of Final Appeal. Mr Justice RIBEIRO has rightly been described as a “colossus” in the legal world. He has made enormously significant contributions to the jurisprudence of Hong Kong and the common law in general. His judgments cover constitutional and public law, human rights law, criminal law, commercial law and company law. Known for their detailed analysis of the law and clarity in thought and presentation, Mr Justice RIBEIRO’s judgments are regularly cited in the local courts and referred to in other leading common law jurisdictions. Mr Justice RIBEIRO is awarded GBM for his distinguished service in the Judiciary.

Mr LIAO Cheung-sing, Andrew, GBS, SC, JP

Over the years, Mr LIAO has served the community with a distinguished record of public service, in particular he has made significant contributions to the higher education sector. As the Chairman of the Council of The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST) since 2015, he has proactively led the HKUST in charting the strategic direction and enhancing the corporate governance of the university. Mr LIAO spearheaded the establishment of the university’s Guangzhou campus and is well respected by the HKUST community. Mr LIAO has made meritorious contributions to promoting intellectual property, cultural and creative industries, as well as innovation and technology development in Hong Kong. Widely respected for his leadership and vision, Mr LIAO is awarded GBM for his exemplary contributions to the public service.

Dr WONG Ying-wai, Wilfred, GBS, JP

Dr WONG is awarded GBM for his distinguished public service, particularly his tremendous contributions to the development of arts and culture, and the creative industry in Hong Kong. As the Chairman of the Hong Kong Arts and Development Council (HKADC) since 2011, Dr WONG has steered the HKADC in introducing arts spaces to meet the demand of arts practitioners, reforming the grants schemes, and bringing Hong Kong's artists and arts groups to the international platform through cultural exchange programmes, thereby enhancing Hong Kong's position as a cultural hub in the region. In addition, in his capacity as the Chairman of the Film Development Council since 2019, Dr WONG is dedicated to promoting the sustained development of the local film industry and cultivating film literacy.

Dr LAM Kin-ngok, Peter, GBS

Dr LAM is awarded GBM in recognition of his exemplary contributions to Hong Kong's trade, business and tourism development. Since 2019, under Dr LAM's chairmanship, the Hong Kong Trade Development Council (HKTDC) has enhanced its support to local enterprises in grasping opportunities in the Mainland and overseas. Dr LAM is also committed to advancing the participation of the business and professional community in the Belt and Road Initiative. Amidst the outbreak of COVID-19, Dr LAM has led the HKTDC to successfully adopt innovative and effective ways in enabling Hong Kong companies to continue doing business globally under the travelling restrictions. Uncle Ray has also helped nurture new singers and bands and is widely regarded as the “Godfather of Hong Kong pop music”.

Ir Dr CHAN Siu-kun, Alex, BBS

Ir Dr CHAN is awarded SBS in recognition of his dedicated community service, in particular his significant contributions to the development of education in Hong Kong. As the Chairman of the Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications (HKCAAVQ) from 2015 to 2021, Ir Dr CHAN has fostered the development of HKCAAVQ into a globally recognised and leading regional independent quality assurance body.

Dr WONG Kwai-kuen, Leo, BBS

Dr WONG is awarded SBS in recognition of his long-term contributions to the local arts sector. With considerable expertise in Chinese painting and calligraphy, Dr WONG has made exemplary contributions in promoting arts and culture by serving as a Museum Expert Advisor since 1990. In 2021, Dr WONG donated to the Hong Kong Museum of Art 1 108 sets in his Jingguanlou Collection which are of exceptional value. This has greatly enhanced the status and importance of the museum as well as Hong Kong to be the centre of Chinese painting and calligraphy of the 20th century.

Mr POON Siu-ping, BBS, MH

Mr POON is awarded SBS in recognition of his meritorious public service, particularly in contributing to the Government's formulation of labour policies. As a veteran and well-respected trade union leader, Mr POON has made unstinting efforts in promoting employees' rights and benefits. During his tenure as a Member of the Legislative Council from 2012 to 2021, Mr POON contributed to the deliberation and enactment of various legislative proposals for improving labour rights and protection.

Miss Siobhan Bernadette HAUGHEY

As an elite swimming athlete, Miss HAUGHEY clinched two silver medals in the Women's 100m and 200m Freestyle events at the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games and set a new Asian record in both events. This is also the first time that Hong Kong won a swimming medal at the Olympic Games.

Mr CHEUNG Ka-long

Mr CHEUNG is awarded SBS in recognition of his outstanding achievements in representing Hong Kong in various international fencing events since 2012, in particular he won a gold medal in the Men's Foil Individual Event at the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games and became the first male athlete in Hong Kong to win an Olympics gold medal.

Mr John Robert SLOSAR

Mr SLOSAR is awarded SBS in recognition of his remarkable contributions in the business and trade development in Hong Kong. As a prominent business leader, a member of the Hong Kong Trade Development Council, as well as the former Chairman of the Hong Kong-United States Business Council, Mr SLOSAR has contributed significantly to the development of Hong Kong's trade with the United States and promotion of Hong Kong as a platform for doing business with the Mainland and throughout Asia.
